HENDRICKS (41.4%) Made by the Grant family of Glenfiddich fame. Deliciously fresh with hints of Bulgarian rose and cucumber	£2.50
TANQUERAY NO10 (47.3%) Hand picked fruits and botanicals that include lemon, orange, coriander, juniper and a hint of camomile. Distilled in a small batch still called "Tiny Ten"	£2.50
CHASE GIN (48%) Using organically grown apples the innovative William Chase distillery in Herefordshire produces this wonderfully fresh gin	£3.50
MILLER'S WESTBOURNE STRENGTH (45.2%) Distilled in old copper stills outside London, and then shipped to Iceland where it is blended with spring water which Millers believes to be the purest in the world	£3.50

CIDER BRANDY, SOMERSET ROYAL (42%) Our own English Calvados? Great apple brandy from Somerset, very fruity with a delicious dusting of oaky vanilla	£3.10
ARMAGNAC - BARON DE SIGOGNAC The Guasch family has been in Gascony since the 12th Century. Baron de Sigognac is a classic Armagnac blended from Ugni Blanc and Baco grapes. Beautifully structured, with hints of prunes and violets on the 10 years old, and with impressions of vanilla and brioche on the 20 years old 10 years old (40%) £3.75 20 Years Old (40%) £5.35	
COGNAC - FRAPIN Succeeding generations of the Frapin family have been established in the Charente area since 1270. The historic firm has its headquarters in Segonzac, the capital of Grande Champagne. As owners of the largest vineyard, a staggering 620 acres, they have access to some amazing cognacs VS (40%) £3.50 Chateau de Fontpinot X.O. (41%) £7.60	

S H E R R Y 50ML

FINO, MARISMENO (15%) Pale, dry and delicate. From Sanchez Romate, established in 1781 and still independent, appointed purveyors to the Royal Family of Spain, to The Vatican and to The House of Lords	£2.65
DRY, AMONTILLADO, LOS ARCOS, LUSTAU (18.5%) The best thing about Sherry is its versatility. This is strictly a dry sherry, and thus a nice aperitif, yet it has just enough sweetness to make it a nice digestif. Delicately fruity, with hints of ripe oranges, citrus zest and almonds	£2.65
DELUXE CREAM, CAPATAZ ANDRES, LUSTAU (20%) Rich and smooth with flavours reminiscent of sweet raisins, dates and figs	£2.65

THE HIGHLANDS

This is Scotland's most vast whisky producing area, which embraces many styles. From the salty, appetising malts of the coastal distilleries to the classic inland 'heather-honey' flavoured malts, there is something for everyone.

EDRADOUR, 10 YEARS OLD (40%) From the smallest distillery in Scotland comes a full-bodied, rich and toffeeish malt, with hints of Christmas cake, chocolate and dried fruits £3.75

ROYAL LOCHNAGAR, 12 YEARS OLD (40%) A sweet, fruity and spicy malt reminiscent of rich Christmas cake, with flavours of ginger, raisins and cinnamon, and a touch of smoke. An exceptional dram to enjoy after dinner £3.75

CAMPBELTOWN

On the southerly tip of the Mull of Kintyre, just two distilleries remain, both making unique, complex and briny malts that reflect the exposed, windswept and bracing conditions on the peninsula.

SPRINGBANK 10 YEARS OLD (46%) Protector and protagonists of the Campbeltown style. Springbank's youngest is characterised by an oily texture, and hints of salt, toffee and toasted coconut £3.75

LONGROW CV (46%) From the Springbank distillery, this blockbuster peaty beast is more reminiscent of something from Islay – Oily, fat and rich – delicious! £3.75

THE LOWLANDS

Lowland production has all but come to a standstill on account of the growing popularity of both Speyside and Islay malts, but this region still has much to offer with its delicately fruity, light to medium-bodied and perfumed whiskies.

AUCHENTOSHAN 12 YEARS OLD (40%) Known affectionately as Glasgow's distillery, Auchentoshan has always produced clean, fresh whisky that is very easy going £3.40

GLENKINCHIE 10 YEARS OLD (43%) Gentle Glenkinchie is known for its subtle spicy and fruity flavours. One of the few whiskies that is a good accompaniment for cheeses £3.55

SPEYSIDE

At the heart of Malt whisky is Speyside, where despite the concentration of distilleries, there is such diversity between the rich, sherried style and the subtly delicate and complex.

BENRIACH, 12 YEARS OLD (40%) Our wine merchant loves this whisky so much he has bought a cask of it for himself – with this kind of endorsement it must be good! £3.45

CRAGGANMORE, 12 YEARS OLD (40%) This characterful Speysider boasts the most complex nose of any malt and is loved by connoisseurs. Clean and dry with barley and cut grass notes £3.60

GLENFARCLAS, 15 YEARS OLD (46%) Well respected by connoisseurs, this family-owned distillery makes a rich, smooth malt with toasty almond and cinnamon flavours and an enduring, warm finish £4.60

ISLAY

With seven distilleries struggling to keep up with demand, Islay boasts the most pungent, smoky and powerful malts of all. Although they are an acquired taste, once you have developed it you will never look back.

CAOL-ILA, 12 YEARS OLD (43%) This little known distillery produces complex, smoky and oily-textured malts. This one has nuances of seaweed, juniper, olives and peaty dryness £3.85

ARDBEG, 10 YEARS OLD (46%) A pungently peaty and smoky malt, yet impeccably balanced with layers of gorse, seaweed, pepper and heather. A full-bodied malt with a long powerful finish £4.10

BRUICHLADDICH, 12 YEARS OLD (46%) This independently owned distillery makes a well balanced malt which is oily textured with subtle island flavours and a warming finish £4.10

THE ISLANDS

Malt whisky is produced on five other islands, Skye, Arran, Orkney, Mull and Jura, each with their own unique style. The selection below offers an insight into some of their characteristics.

ARRAN – ISLE OF ARRAN, 10 YEARS OLD (46%) From the popular holiday destination of Arran, this newly built distillery has at last come of age. Butterscotch and barley, beautiful £3.85

ORKNEY - HIGHLAND PARK, UNCHILLFILTERED, SIGNATORY (46%) This popular ‘all-rounder’ from Orkney has all the heather, honey and sherry notes of a good Speysider impeccably balanced with the toasty smokiness of an Islay malt. Unchillfiltered at 46% too! £4.70

IRISH WHISKEY

Irish Whiskey differs from Scotch whisky not only by how it is spelled, but also in terms of both raw materials and distilling. It enjoys a similar level of popularity, yet few distilleries remain.

BUSHMILLS, 10 YEARS OLD (40%) Maturation firstly in a bourbon barrel and then in a sherry butt, gives this a degree of complexity rarely attained by Irish whiskeys £4.35

RAMOS PINTO Founded in 1880 by Adriano Ramos-Pinto, this Port House has always had a pioneering spirit - from its distinctive “art nouveau” advertising of the beginning of the century to the continuing wide-ranging vineyard research in the Upper Douro valley.
